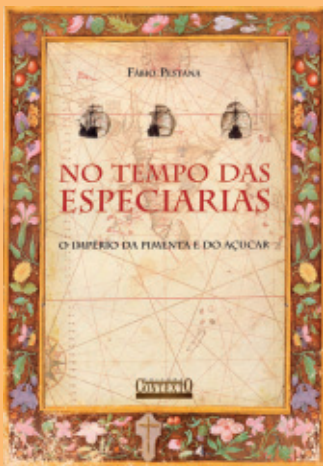

From the rigid patriarchal family to the “amorous disorder” provided by the contraceptive pill and the feminist revolution, from passionate love to love that leads to marriage, from flirting to dating, the author delineates centuries of amorous life in Brazil. *História do amor no Brasil* is the ideal reading for men and women who want to understand love and live of the feeling most celebrated in History. **336 pages.**

The History of Children in Brazil (História das crianças no Brasil) Mary Del Priore (ed.)

In this book, Brazilian children are historical subjects such as the little travelers of the XVI century caravels, the indigenous *curumins* submitted to catechesis by the Jesuits, the slave kids, the childhood of the rich and poor, the boys who took part in the Paraguayan war, the little workers, and those abandoned and exploited as cheap labour. Memories from different childhood experiences illuminate both past and present. **448 pages.**

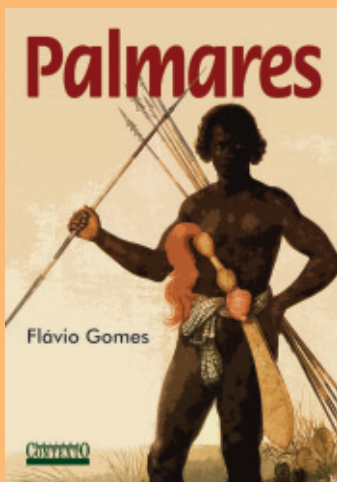

The History of Women in Brazil (História das mulheres no Brasil) Mary Del Priore (ed.)

História das mulheres no Brasil follows the trajectory of women in Brazil from colonial times to the present. It is designed for all kinds of readers – adults and young people, experts and laypersons, students and professors – taking them back over a journey through time. This book shows how women in Brazil were born, how they lived and how they died. The material and symbolic worlds around them are also depicted. A careful examination of geographical regions and sections of Brazilian society is proffered. The countryside and the city, the north and south of Brazil, slaves, proletarians, *sinhazinhas*, bourgeois, housewives, teachers and rural workers all come under scrutiny. **680 pages.**





Palmares

Flávio Gomes

The book covers the history of Palmares – the biggest and most famous community of fugitive slaves in the history of the Americas established during the XVI century. It addresses the constant battles against the authorities until the death of its leader, Zumbi, and the ensuing decline of the community.

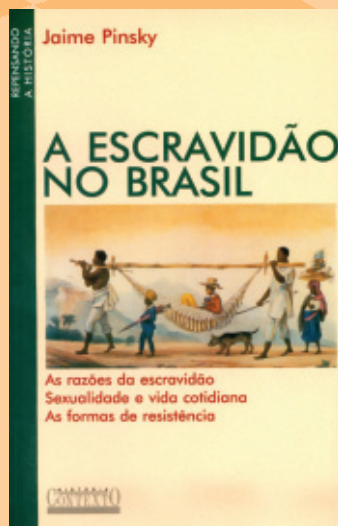
Slavery in Brazil

Brazil was the last country on the American continent to abolish slavery in 1888. This book centers on the lucrative traffic in slaves, the everyday life of the slaves at work and in the *senzala* (slaves house), their sexual life and the resistance mounted by the blacks against oppression. **96 pages.**

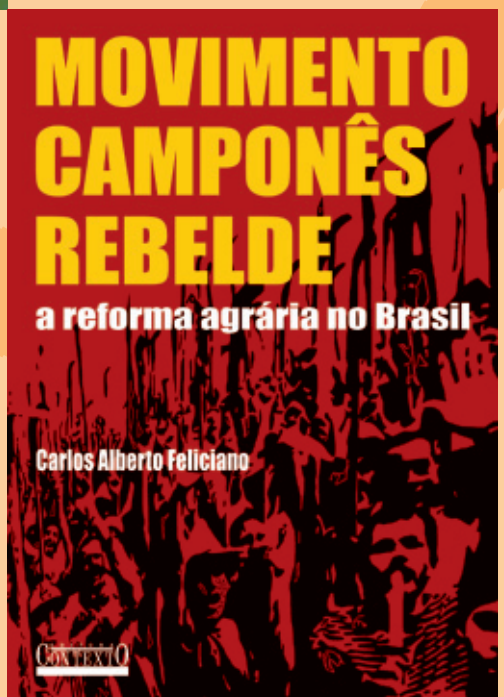
Agricultural Worker's Rebellion: agrarian reform in Brazil

The History of Citizenship

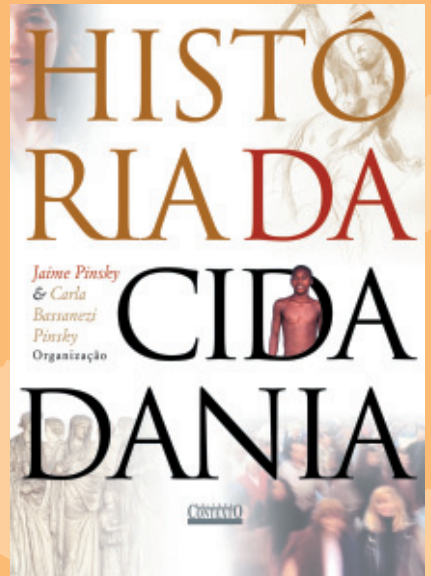

This book examines the historical process that led western society to conquer these rights, as well as the steps that should be taken in order to integrate those who are still not full citizens. This volume starts with the pre-history of citizenship, analyzes the basis of modern citizenship, describes its expansion and turns the focus to Brazil. Published for the first time, this book organizes the discussion on a subject upon which much has been said but little is known. It brings some light to a concept that has become empty through misuse and provides solid and coherent reflection. **592 pages.**

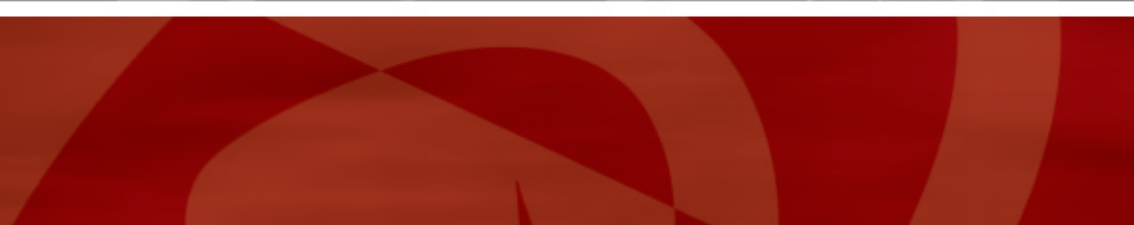
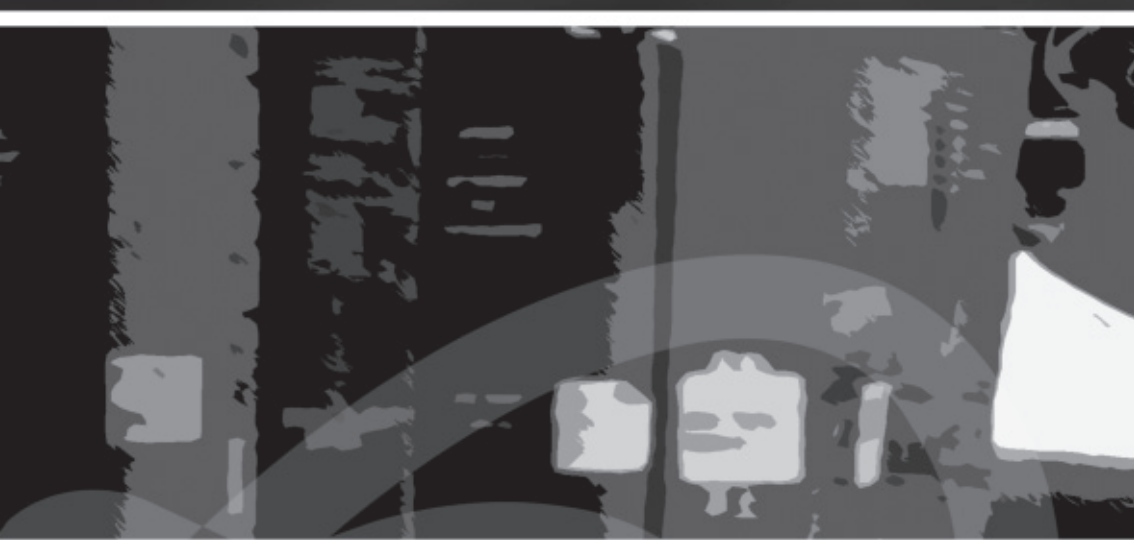
